THE 103 CLUB AT SPRAGUE

The 103 Club at Sprague School is for children in Kindergarten through second grade. It opens on the first day of school and continues throughout the school year. We are only closed on national holidays, weekends, summers and part of winter break. The 103 Club is open all other days when school is closed, including in-service (teacher institute) days, given that at least ten students are registered in advance.

When school is in session, The 103 Club hours are 6:30-9:00 a.m. (before school) and 2:30-6:30 p.m. (after school).

When school is not in session, The 103 Club hours for full days are 6:30 a.m.-6:30 p.m.

The minimum number of days is 2 per week. If a parent registers a child for a week (5 days), the cost is the same as for 4 days; therefore, the 5th day is free. There is a \$30 non-refundable registration fee per child each year to cover administrative costs and a t-shirt for your child to wear on field trips.

The 103 Club offers activities, such as sports, arts & crafts, computers, science, as well as a healthy snack. We encourage all children to participate in activities but offer them the choice. We offer a head-start program (after the daily activity project) for those children who require homework time. The 103 Club provides high quality, before and after school children's programs for working parents when school is in session, and full-day programs on the days when school is closed, such as holidays, inservice days, etc.
